



Hip Injury

Condition

A 38-year - old female, is pregnant with her second child and has been a patient of the clinic for years. She presented at the clinic with severe pain following a unguarded step off a curb, during which she felt immediate sharp pain in the sacroiliac joint. Since the patient had already been seen at the clinic and already had had x - rays taken before her pregnancy, we were able to safely start treating her.

Medical Assessment

Physical examination revealed tenderness to palpation in the right sacroiliac joint.

Treatment Suggestion

Our suggested clinical plan is to address the malalignment of the patients' spine through gently applying the **KKT**[®] treatment device.

Results of Treatment

During the first treatment, the patient required help going from standing to sitting to lying down, due to the intensity of the sacroiliac joint pain. Following that treatment, the patient was advised to rest and asked to return for another treatment two days later. During that second visit the patient reported that the pain intensity had decreased by 80% since the previously treatment, two day prior. Palpation could only elicit minimal pain, and the patient was able to move around into various positions on her own and without pain. On a follow - up visit four days after that, the pain had resolved, much to the relief of the patient, who would be going into labor two weeks later.
